Floating wetlands for the port of Hamburg

Landscapes, consisting of buoyancy bodies, plant substrate and vegetation, create and connect different underwater and above-water habitats for many species. The above-water habitats are important for insects as well as for birds and mammals, which find protected places to rest, nest and feed in the different vegetation structures. In the underwater habitats, the root areas of the vegetation and the deadwood in particular are important habitats for microorganisms and fish.

At the same time, floating wetlands can serve as places to experience nature and make the port of Hamburg also more attractive for people.

- ✓ Creating habitats for fish, birds, insects and mammals
- ✓ Creating a place to experience nature
